The submission form will be available on line starting from the issue of the Rector's Decree until the deadline indicated in the Decree.

Please note: The candidate is entirely responsible for filling out the application form. Applications that do not result "Validated" (completed and closed) online by the application deadline will be considered void, as well as applications containing incorrect or untrue data.

1. Requirements and instructions for the application

Students enrolled in a bachelor course, master's degree, single cycle degree programme, Ph.D. meeting the requirements as indicated in the 2025-2026 Erasmus+ Call of the University can apply to the Erasmus+ program.

In particular:

a) For the purposes of the ranking, as for the three-year bachelor degree first year students, the exams taken by the end of the first semester (winter session) will be considered. If the exams are not registered on Delphi yet, they can still be added in the appropriate field specifying the denomination of the exam, marks and credits and attaching a proof of the exam taken (mail from the responsible Professor or from Delphi portal).

Only students who achieved at least 6 credits by the end of the first semester exam session can apply; differently their application will not be considered valid.

b) Students transferred from other universities or graduated at other universities must enter the

exams taken in the appropriate field, specifying the denomination of the exam, marks and credits and attaching a digital scan of the official passed exams certificate;

c) As for students who have obtained a bachelor degree abroad, the weighted grade point average (see Evaluation criteria) will be calculated by converting the degree grade into thirtieths;

d) PhD students must submit the application form by e-mail, including:

- CV Resume
- Research project
- Language certificate/declaration

e) Students enrolled in the last year of the Bachelor degree who wish to apply to carry out the program during the Master's degree can send the application and, if admitted to the ranking, may have the scholarship assigned conditionally; in case they are not able to provide the certificate of enrolment to the Master's Degree by the deadline indicated by the Erasmus+ Office, the assignment will be revoked.

f) Language certificates, certifications and linguistic self-certifications (*Dichiarazioni sostitutive di certificazioni in possesso, Art. 46 D.P.R. 445 del 2000*) must be uploaded as attachments.

2. Evaluation criteria for ranking list and selection of candidates

The ranking list will be the result of:

- Weighted grade point average: obtained considering the number of credits of all exams passed and registered on Delphi by the end of the first semester (winter session);

- Student performance: the ratio between the credits earned and the number of years attended since enrolment to the Bachelor's Degree Course.

All the exams passed during the Bachelor's and the Master's Degree Courses will be evaluated without any distinction. Bachelor's Degree final mark will not be evaluated (unless in case of degrees obtained abroad, as specified above). The number of full marks with honors (30 e lode) obtained will be considered only in the case of an equal score in the final ranking list. In the event of a further equal score, the youngest candidate will be favoured in compliance with *art.3, Law 127/97* and *art.2, paragraph 9, Law 191/98*. Exams whose marks are not in thirtieths will not be considered.

Note: As per decision of the Boards of the Degree Courses of Mechatronics and Engineering Sciences, students enrolled in these Degree Courses must have a score of at least 28 in the Erasmus ranking list (not the weighted grade point average) in order to receive the grant.

Each Degree Course will have its final ranking list. Grants will be assigned separately to students of each Degree Course (possible combination of similar Degree Courses can be considered). Candidates will pick their destination according to the ranking list order of each Degree Course (provided that they meet the requirements for the specific destination, both as regards language skills and study level).

In the event that scholarships for PhD students are available for a specific destination, the ranking will still prioritize students from Bachelor's and Master's degree courses.

As for the following grants, the assignation can be decided by the Erasmus+ Coordinator in charge of the agreement. Grants may not be assigned if the Coordinator decides that requirements for the

specific destination are not met. To this regard, students interested in the above-mentioned destinations are suggested to refer to the Erasmus+ Coordinator in charge of the agreement beforehand:

- Université De Provence - Aix Marseille, École Nationale Supérieure Des Techniques Avancées, Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Mines de Saint-Etienne (Ingegneria Medica)
- Haute École Spécialisée de Suisse Occidentale e Haute École d'Ingegnerie et Gestion du Canton de Vaud (Ingegneria Energetica)

3. Language skills requirements

Each destination can require a defined level of certified/declared linguistic knowledge, as listed in this annex from page 7 (note: some language requirements may vary from the date of publication of the call for applications to the time of application to the host university). In fact, the program is based on agreements between the sending and receiving Universities, which, in most cases, require a specific language level (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2). According to the bilateral agreements, the hosting University could reject a student whose language level is not adequate, even after the assignment of the grant.

Therefore, the grants will be assigned **with priority given** to the students that already have the requested language certification/declaration and have attached it to the application; **secondly, priority will be given** to the students that will obtain the certificate after the call closing date but before the assignation of grants. Thirdly, priority will be given to students that still have to achieve the required certification, for mobility in the second semester only. In this case, the grant assignment will be **conditional and revocable** by the Erasmus+ Office if the certification required is not achieved by the deadline indicated by the Erasmus+ Office.

If the student is not able to provide the required documents certifying the language level by the deadline, the assigned grant will be cancelled and given to the next candidate on the ranking list.

According to the different agreements, an official declaration by an Institute can be sufficient as proof of the language level. Whereas, if according to the agreement it is mandatory to provide a language certification, it has to be issued by one of the following Institutions:

English language:

- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)
- ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages – University of Cambridge)
- ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages – University of Pitman)
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System – University of Cambridge)
- ISE (Integrated Skills in English – Trinity College London)
- LCCIEB (London Chamber of Commerce & Industry Examinations Board)

French language:

- DELF (Diplôme d'études en langue française – Alliance Française)
- DALF (Diplôme approfondi de langue française – Alliance Française)

German language:

- ZD (Zertifikat Deutsch – Goethe Institut/ OSD)
- ZDfB (Zertifikat Deutsch für den Beruf – Goethe Institut/ OSD)
- ZMP (Zentrale Mittelstufenprüfung – Goethe Institut/ OSD)
- ZOP (Zentrale Oberstufenprüfung – Goethe Institut/OSD)

Spanish language:

- DELE (Diplomas de Español como Lengua Extranjera)

A self-certification from the candidate declaring to be a native speaker of the language is accepted after proper examination and C2 level will be assigned. For students enrolled in a Bachelor/Master course degree in English a B2 level (English) is recognised.

The stay in a foreign country, certified or self-certified, of at least 3 months for study or work purposes (for example, *Erasmus+*, *Traineeship*, *Overseas*, or other mobility projects) for students enrolled at Tor Vergata University will be evaluated and recognised as B2 level knowledge, unless they achieved an upper level taking the linguistic online support (OLS) exam. For all the other students, it is necessary to provide an official certificate of attendance of one of the projects above mentioned.

For equivalences between the required linguistic skills and the declaration's levels based on the QCER, please refer to our Academic Centre Language (CLA): [Erasmus outgoing – Centro Linguistico di Ateneo](#)

Erasmus+ gives the opportunity to all participants to improve their language skills before and during the mobility abroad through a European service of Online Language Support (OLS), which gives them the possibility to both evaluate their language knowledge and attend a free online course to improve their skills.

Furthermore, students interested in participating in the Erasmus+ program can attend classes potentially organized by CLA.

The linguistic knowledge level will be assigned by the Commission after an evaluation based entirely on the documentation attached to the application. It is highly recommended that the student attaches all the documents in his/her possession.

1. Publication of ranking lists, assignation of grants and signing of contracts

The final ranking list will be divided by Degree Course and published on the website <http://mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus>.

On-line publication of the ranking list has legal value and constitutes an official notice for all selected candidates. Students are expected to personally check the ranking list, no other forms of communication of the results are foreseen.

After the rankings will be published online, the procedures for the grants assignation will also be published on the website <http://mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus>. The Erasmus+ scholarships will be assigned by the Commission appointed by the Rector.

Students will indicate their preferred destination at the meeting for the assignation of grants, according to their position in the ranking, after verification of the requirements by the Commission. Students are expected to get information about the courses offered by each partner University which are of their own interest and available, by consulting the website **before the choice of destination**.

Appeals: Appeals should be signed and submitted on unstamped paper (no tax stamp required). Reasons for the appeal should be clearly expressed. Appeals shall be submitted to the Engineering Erasmus+ Office **within five days from the ranking list publication on-line** (please contact Daniela Mannino Tel: +39 06 72597506 email: daniela.mannino@uniroma2.it).

For students selected for the Erasmus+ grant who after signing the contract will not leave for the mobility period and will not submit their formal renunciation on time for serious reasons, what is written in the University call will be applied. If a waiver is received on time, the next candidate on the ranking list will be assigned the grant, if meeting all requirements.

Students awarded the scholarship must follow the subsequent procedural steps as indicated in the Decree.

4. Grant disbursement and registration of exams

In order to obtain the grant, the student shall achieve a minimum of credits during mobility abroad as specified in the University Erasmus+ call.

In order to set up the "package recognition" as explicated in the University announcement the student must keep in mind the following indications:

a. It is essential that the student obtains at least 2/3 of the ECTS-CFU for the corresponding course at the foreign University (examples: 8 ECTS-CFU for 12 ECTS-CFU). The remaining credits must be obtained from the foreign University in a similar academic field (*settore scientifico-disciplinare*) or subjects that are relevant to that specific course. Additional course integrations or tests are no longer allowed on site after the program, neither written, oral nor practical.

Students who only achieve 2/3 (or more) of the ECTS-CFU in the corresponding discipline at Rome Tor Vergata, but not the whole amount, will have to follow the indications that each single course (as communicated by the Delegate) establishes for the achievement of credits in disciplines similar to that indicated on the Learning Agreement in order to complete the rest of the credits.

In order to calculate the ECTS-CFUs, in the "packages" other activities apart from the exams (course attendance, laboratories, internships, language courses and all ECTS-CFU allowed from the study courses) with the equivalent credits can also be included, as long as they have been agreed before departure and are indicated in the learning agreement.

b. In the "package" mobility it is possible to include the bibliographic research activity for bachelor/master degree thesis for students who have completed all the exams required by their program structure/curriculum.

c. The procedure for the recognition of exams taken abroad is carried out by the degree course secretariat where the request is submitted. For this purpose, the following procedure is recommended:

- Consult the website of the host University where the scholarship was awarded;
- Download the syllabus of the courses that you intend to attend and have them approved, or confirmed, through the appropriate form by the Coordinator of the degree course, who will then coordinate with the Delegated Professors;
- The student is free to request further recognition of equivalences during the program at the

partner University, to the extent that the request is made to the Coordinator of the degree course, or to the Delegate Professor, by e-mail. A link of the course to be recognised should be attached, with program description, number of credits, hours of attendance.

d. In order to validate the exams taken or other education activities carried out abroad during the Erasmus+ Program, please note that:

- To apply for the recognition of the study period abroad, students must obtain authorisation (nullaosta) from the Erasmus+ University office, which will issue it when the student has regularized his administrative issues.

- It should be noted that, as a rule, certificates and declarations related to exams taken might require significant technical transmission time. It is therefore preferable, if the Erasmus+ coordinator of the Partner University allows it, to ask for a further certification of the exams taken, or alternatively, a copy of the certification authenticated with the University's registered stamp. If the delay in the transmission of the certificates compromises the participation in a graduation session or the assignment of other scholarships or other rights, it is advisable to communicate these needs in advance to the Engineering Erasmus+ Office staff who will take care of informing partner Universities.

- The “packages” of the exams achieved abroad are formally submitted to the interested Degree course for approval and forwarded directly to the students’ Secretariat of the School of Engineering for registration.

- Germany

The German Federal Office for Migration and Refugees requires non-EU students to provide proof of sufficient financial means for their exchange semester in Germany. The amount required is 934 € for each month of mobility. Part of this amount is covered by the ERASMUS+ scholarship, of course, but the rest has to be provided by the students.

- United Kingdom

For study stays of more than 6 months, the UK requires the Secure English Language Test certificate to obtain a visa.
