Macro area of mathematics, physics and natural sciences Annex to the Erasmus+ 2023/24 call for applications

1. Eligibility criteria and requirements

To submit an application, regardless of their country of citizenship, students must be enrolled in an undergraduate, graduate or single-cycle degree programme, a PhD programme run by the Università di Roma Tor Vergata. Moreover, applicants must meet the requirements provided by the Erasmus+ Programme call for applications in 2023/2024 and by this annexe.

In particular, as regards the macro area of mathematics, physics and natural sciences, students entitled to apply are:

For universities that signed an agreement providing the **undergraduate level**, students regularly enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree course in this macro area and who obtained an average grade higher than 20/30;

- 1.1 Students enrolled in the <u>first year of a Bachelor's Degree course</u> who obtained at least 15 credits (with an average grade higher than 20/30). Applications of students who did not get at least 15 credits within the call deadline shall be considered invalid.
- 1.2 Students enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree course who have not passed their exams within the schedule or who repeated no more than one academic year are entitled to participate.

For universities that signed an agreement providing the **postgraduate level**, students regularly enrolled in a Master's Degree course of this macro area and who obtained an average grade higher than 20/30 calculated on the <u>entire course of study</u> (Bachelor's and Master's Degree courses);

PhD students of this macro area for the universities that signed an Agreement providing the doctoral level.

For universities that signed an agreement providing the **pharmacy** subject area, students regularly enrolled in a One-cycle Degree in the pharmacy of this macro area and who obtained an average grade higher than 20/30 and at least 20 credits.

2. Application submission requirements and procedures

Applications must be submitted online only through the following link: mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus/candidatura within the deadline of the Erasmus+ Programme call for applications 2023/2024.

To apply, enter the same username and password for the Student Portal Delphi.

Before applying, candidates must log in at the website htt://delphi.uniroma2.it and check that the available on their personal Delphi page is correctly updated. If not, promptly report any anomalies to the Student Secretary during the opening hours. On the contrary, the ranking list will be based on the data recorded in the system.

The ranking list will be calculated considering all the academic career data up to the deadline of the Erasmus Call.

Candidates must manually enter all the exams which still need to be registered in the online system, uploading a copy of the screenshot in the same section of the Delphi web page with the pending exams.

As regards students enrolled in a Master's Degree course, graduated in another university or abroad must enter the exams in the dedicated section and upload the degree certificate with the final score, the enrollment date, exams and grades, and all the activities with marks and credits of the Bachelor's Degree course.

As regards students enrolled in a Master's Degree course graduated abroad must upload the exams in the dedicated section and upload the degree certificate with the final score, the enrollment date, exams and grades, and all the activities with marks and credits of the Bachelor's Degree course and the declaration of value for the translation of the





final grade according to the Italian grading system.

3. Linguistic Knowledge

Only for the online application at this Erasmus+ Call, the following documents will be valid as follows:

- An official certificate from a school nationally and/or internationally recognised attesting the level reached, if expired, will be considered as a linguistic knowledge statement.
- self-certification of a stay abroad certified for at least four months for study or work reasons (e.g. *Erasmus+, Traineeship, Overseas* or other mobility projects) will be considered a B2 level (it is also possible to upload the OLS final test);
- self-certification for students enrolled in degree programs entirely taught in English in this university will be considered a B2 level (English).

A minimum level of language skills is required to apply for an Erasmus+ 2023/2024 grant. Students must check the host university's language requirements where they intend to spend their Erasmus+ period. The language requirements are specified in the list of available exchange vacancies. The list is available at the end of this annexe. All documents must be uploaded in pdf format when applying. Failure to do so may result in the application being rejected. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. It will not be possible to change applications after submission. Before applying, students are kindly invited to double-check it. 4. Selection procedures: award criteria

The final score will be calculated by summing two numbers that express the average grade and the evaluation of credits compared to rates and credits obtained during the course on which the student is enrolled at the moment of submitting the application. As regards students enrolled in a Master's Degree course or a PhD, the evaluation will be made, as described above, based on the Bachelor's Degree course and the Master's Degree course. For students enrolled in a PhD course, also the Master's Degree final grade will be considered.

As regards international students enrolled in a Master's Degree course or a PhD course, the evaluation shall be completed after an additional interview to assess the previous academic skills. Furthermore, in case of equal scores between students of the same course, students with a language certificate will be ranked higher in the pass list. If the final score is equal between students of the same course, students enrolled in subsequent years will have a higher position in the pass list. If the final score is equal between a Bachelor's Degree student and a Master's Degree student, the latter will be ranked higher in the pass list. If the final score is equal among PhD students, the higher grade of the Master's Degree course will be preferred.

A preliminary pass list shall be published on the website http://mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus. After the publication of the preliminary list, students will be allowed to submit possible observations and/or appeals within five days (deadline is 12.00 am on the fifth day) by sending an email to erasmus@scienze.uniroma2.it. After that period, the final pass list will be published.

5. Acceptance

Students on the pass-list must attend the **Acceptance meeting to sign** the contract. The meeting date will be indicated by the International Relations Office/Erasmus+ at the Schools of mathematics, physics and natural sciences on this website: http://mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus.

During that meeting, the exchange place will be accepted in accordance with the pass-list order. The student's mobility is subject to being taken by the host university (with specific reference to the epidemiological situation of the covid-19 in the partner countries).

After the acceptance meeting, students must fill in the Application Form and the Learning Agreement form required by the host university. The Learning Agreement form is available on the home university's website on the following website: http://mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus or on the host university's website. In the Learning Agreement, students





must indicate the study activities they want to complete during the mobility period. The Learning Agreement must be signed by the person responsible for the Erasmus+ at the sending university (for contact persons, please check the lists on pages from 5 to 9). The person responsible for Erasmus+ who will sign the Learning Agreement is a professor nominated by the Council of the study course.

Hence, students must submit the form to the International Relations Office/Erasmus+ at the Schools of mathematics, physics and natural sciences, which, if required, will send it to the host university. In case of approval, the host university will sign and send it back.

Shouldn't there be a formal requirement of a specific knowledge of a language (as indicated next to the name of the host university), Students can avail themselves of language courses and services provided by the university Language Center (CLA, http://cla.uniroma2.it/) to acquire a minimum level of skills in the language of the host country. The level of knowledge has to be proven by certification. In the absence of certificate, students will be submitted to an interview test by the evaluating commission. Ultimately, if a student is not proven to have acquired language skills, the following first ranked student will take over.

Modifications to the study plan are allowed before departure or during the mobility period. They must be promptly submitted to the person responsible for approval and then sent to the International Relations Office/Erasmus+ at the Schools of mathematics, physics and natural sciences.

Each of the host universities establishes its own deadlines and procedures for submitting the Application form and Learning Agreement. The student will monitor the deadlines on the host university web page. That information is generally found in the section for incoming exchange students (see the list of available exchange vacancies below).

Once returned from the mobility period, study activities and credits acquired will be registered in the student profile by the last version of the Learning Agreement previously signed by both host and home universities. The recognition of activities and exams is realised by the Council of the study course on the basis of the certification from the host university (Transcript of Records) and sent to International Relations Office/Erasmus+ at the Schools of mathematics, physics and natural sciences, at the end of the mobility period.
