MACROAREA OF SCIENCES MM.FF.NN.
TO THE ERASMUS+ RE-OPENING OF ERASMUS+ CALL FOR STUDY (KA131-EU)
FOR THE SECOND SEMESTER a.y. 2025/26

Application deadline: July 16th 2025 at 12:00

1- Eligibility criteria

The Erasmus+ Call for Study is open to students enrolled in a degree programme, master's degree, single cycle master's degree and PhD course at the University of Rome Tor Vergata in A.A. 2024/ 2025. You can see the requirements of the Erasmus+ Call 2025/2026 and in this annex to the Call.

Specifically, in the Macroarea of Science MM.FF.NN. the requirements are:

- For those enrolled in the bachelor's degree:
 - 1) Have an average of **21/30** or more.
 - 2) First year students have achieved at least **12 CFU**; second year students have achieved at least **45 CFU**; third year students have achieved at least **75 CFU**; first year students have achieved at least **105 CFU**.
 - 3) Not be enrolled out of the course for more than one year.
 - 4) Not be listed in precautionary.
- For those enrolled in the master's degree:
 - 1) Have an average of **24/30** or more over the entire course of studies (Bachelor's + master's degree).
 - 2) First year students have achieved at least **12 CFU***; second year students have achieved at least **45 CFU**; first year students have achieved at least **75 CFU**.
 - 3) Not be enrolled out of the course for more than one year.

**Students enrolled in the first year of the Master's Degree in Human Nutrition Science, given the structure of the course, are exempt from the requirement to have achieved at least 12 CFU.*

- For those enrolled in the master's degree course in Pharmacy:
 - 1) Students regularly enrolled from the third year of the Pharmacy course, who have achieved at least **60 CFU** and who have reached an average above **24/30**.
 - 2) Not be enrolled out of course for more than one year.
- For doctoral students: to be enrolled in a doctoral course.

2- Application procedures and deadlines

The application for participation must be submitted exclusively by electronic means through the website mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus/candidatura within the mandatory deadline indicated in the University's announcement. To access the online application, you must enter the same username and password used to access the Delphi Student Portal. The deadline for applying is very strict, so it suggests avoiding preparing the application in the last few days before the deadline.

Before starting to fill in the online application form, students must check that their career data is up-to-date and complete by accessing the student's private area on the Student Portal (<http://delphi.uniroma2.it/>). In case of inaccuracies and/or omissions, the student has to report them to the Students' Office respecting the reception hours. If not, the ranking will be based on the data in the system.

The exams, which are not registered on the Delphi platform, must be entered manually, attaching in the same section the Delphi screen with the list of the exams being recorded. The ranking will be based on career data at the end of the Call. All examinations recorded after the expiry date will not be considered.

For students enrolled in a master's degree programme, the previous career will also be considered. For students enrolled in a master's degree course who have obtained their degree at another University in Italy or abroad, it will be necessary

to enter all the exams taken in the appropriate field and upload the certificate of graduation that carries the final grade, the date of first enrolment, examinations and teaching activities with the corresponding marks and credits obtained during graduation and declaration.

This documentation must be requested from the Students' Secretariat of the University from which you come.

Please note that after validation of the application, no changes will be possible. Therefore, before validating the online application, students are invited to verify that the application is correctly filled in by contacting the Erasmus+ Office of the Macroarea of Sciences, at the following address:

3- Ranking and evaluation criteria

For students enrolled in undergraduate, master's or single cycle degree courses, the score will be determined by the sum of the weighted average of the credits divided by thirty and the ratio between the credits obtained and expected credits. In the case of students enrolled in the master's degree, the evaluation will be attributed based on the current and previous career, carried out both within the framework of the degree and the masters. For students enrolled in the PhD, the score will be awarded based on the grade of the master's degree and an interview to assess the relevance of Erasmus mobility for the student's research project.

In the case of students who have obtained a foreign degree, evaluation will be carried out for degrees obtained in other countries, including through an additional interview to assess their knowledge and previous skills.

The date and modalities of the interview for doctoral students and students who have obtained a degree abroad, will be communicated by e-mail to the e-mail entered during the application process. The communication will require confirmation of attendance at the interview. If you fail to give notice or are absent from the interview, you will no longer be eligible for an Erasmus grant.

In the case of equal merit between students enrolled in a degree course and students enrolled in a master's degree course in the same area, students enrolled in the master's degree are ranked first. In the case of a equal merit between students enrolled in a PhD course, the candidates with the best degree score are ranked first. Finally, in the case of further parity, the youngest candidate is preferred.

The preliminary ranking will be published on the website mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus. From this publication, students will have the opportunity to submit any comments and/or appeals on the merits, no later than 12:00 on the fifth day following that date, by writing to erasmus@scienze.uniroma2.it. The final ranking will be published as soon as the deadlines for submitting comments and/or appeals have been met, and any deadlines that may have been reached are set.

4- The Host University's requirements and procedures for the award

Students eligible in the ranking must present themselves to the assignment meeting on the date set which will be indicated on the website mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus. The order of the award will be in this place.

It is important to note that the student's mobility is always conditional on the acceptance of the Host University and the fulfilment of the requirements required by the location. For information and deadlines, please consult the Fact Sheet and/or the website of the Partner Office. After the assignment of the place, it will be necessary to submit the online application (Application Form) on the Host University's website and fill out a study project (Learning Agreement). The Learning Agreement is available in the section "Student enrolled in Tor Vergata/student on mobility" at the following address mobint.uniroma2.it/erasmus/ or on the Host University's website (where required). The Learning Agreement should list the educational activities that you intend to carry out at the Host University and their correspondence with the study plan of the Home University.

The Learning Agreement must be approved by the Erasmus+ teacher responsible for his or her course of study and signed by the Erasmus Coordinator of Macroarea. The names and contact details of the responsible lecturers are given in the list below. Upon signature of the coordinator, the student must send the document to the host site for acceptance.

Since each site independently establishes deadlines and procedures for the submission of the Application Form and the Learning Agreement, it will be the responsibility of the winners to monitor the deadlines on the website of the host site. This information is usually found on the respective sites, in the section for Incoming Exchange Students (Incoming Exchange Students).

Following the assignment, the student must submit, if required and within the terms set by the foreign office, an official certificate indicating the level of knowledge of the language (A1, A2, B1, B2, C1, C2 according to the Common Framework of Reference for Languages recognized by the Council of Europe - CEFR) to the Host University awarded, under penalty of cancellation of the scholarship. The language level and certificate type are indicated for information in the list of the exchange offer below for each place banned, but it is recommended that each student checks the information on the website of the place.

Please note that language requirements may vary according to field and course. Students are therefore invited to check, in addition to the table below, the page of the Host University's Faculty.

Please note that the University Language Centre (CLA, <http://cla.uniroma2.it/>) offers students enrolled in a course of study at the University of Tor Vergata the opportunity to enroll in a language proficiency course by acquiring a minimum level of knowledge of the language of the host country. Students eligible for the examination may apply to the same Centre for a certificate attesting to their CEFR language level.

5- Final considerations

Changes to the study plan are allowed before departure or during the period of use of the scholarship. Changes to the study plan must be submitted promptly for approval by the responsible person and then forwarded to the Erasmus+ Office of the Macroarea of Science.

Upon return from mobility, the teaching activities and related credits acquired on mobility will be recognized in your career, based on the latest version of the Learning Agreement approved by the Home and Host Universities. The recognition is carried out by the competent Council of Study Courses, based on the certificate of the educational activities carried out at the host institution (Transcript of Records) and transmitted to the University of origin (Erasmus + Office of the Macroarea of Sciences).

The duration of the scholarships indicated in this call corresponds to that established in the bilateral agreements; however, it is clarified that this reopening of the call is valid only for departures for the second semester academic year 2025/2026 and shall be concluded by 30 September 2026.
